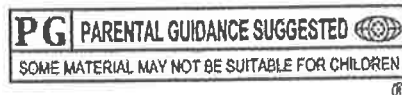

General Audiences



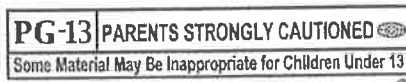
G Means that it is Suitable for viewing by people of all ages. G-rated pictures do not necessarily mean children's motion picture. It is meant for everyone of any age to watch.
